

How to Write a Literature Review in Research

A literature review is a kind of survey to find out different sources regarding a particular topic. Literature reviews allow you to analyze different methods and theories which have been applied in different literature. A literature review is also used to find out the gaps in the existing research. It includes the critical analysis of different publications like books and articles of journals etc. While writing a literature review, you need to follow the [essay writer service](#). The key elements of the literature review are searching, evaluation, identification, outlining, and writing. It does not rely on the summary of sources rather it analyzes and critically evaluates the sources.

Before going to write the literature review students should read the instructions of the assignment clearly. They should spend their maximum time reading and understanding the instructions provided by their teacher or professor. Most of the time students fail in developing an efficient literature review just because of their negligence in reading and understanding the basic instructions. A literature review helps in finding the gaps in the existing literature so it includes the good reading and researching skills of the students. An **essay writer** or researcher should keep their focus on the main points of the text instead of reading the whole book or article.

Many students find the literature review the most difficult part of their research. Students can use "[college essay writer](#)" service providers to get the literature review of their research paper. Service providers can provide students with expert writers who work according to the requirements of the assignments and demands of the students. If you know the writing and research techniques it is not difficult for you to write a literature review. Some of the tips to write a literature review for a research paper in no time are as follows:

Narrow your Topic of Research

Narrow down your area of the study. Brainstorm what makes the topic interesting for you and other writers. Consult with your instructor, brainstorm, and read different issues of your field and the lectures to specify your area of research. Make your scope limited to the area of the topic. It will become difficult to get the required sources if the topic is broad. The broad topics demand more extensive research which takes more time and complicates the process as well.

Search Process

First of all, define the selection criteria for the sources. Define the period, geographical area, or the specific methodology on which you want sources. Use different keywords and library databases to search for different sources. The reference lists of the recent articles can also provide a guideline for [essay writer](#). Search for such sources which are opposing your point of view. Before writing a literature review, make sure to search all those sources which need to be included in the research paper.

Evaluation of Selected Sources

Once you have selected the articles, thoroughly read and evaluate them. Evaluate the assumptions which the other writers have made. Evaluate the mythologies and procedures being used in other articles. Analyze different theories, results, and methodologies regarding the topic which you have selected. Critically evaluate how these theories have been evaluated with time. Read main sections of the sources instead of reading the whole text.

Organization of Sources

After reading, move towards the organization of the sources. Find out the common findings in the sources. Highlight the trends of the research. Pick up the most influential theories from different sources. Try to fit your findings under different headings or make sub-headings to fit them. Make headings and subheadings according to the different patterns and the themes you have selected for the research.

Purpose Statement

Develop a thesis statement or purpose statement, after analyzing a different number of sources on your topic. The different trends and developments in different articles can help to develop a statement. It will make the search process and organization of the content easier for the researcher. It identifies the aspects of the topic which need to be searched and saves time for the writer.

Writing Process

To write a literature review, follow the structure or the outline that you have created for writing. Craft headings and subheadings in a paper to incorporate different points in writing. There should be a link between each heading and subheading. Do not start each paragraph with the name of the researcher; it indicates that you have just summarized the work of the other writer. Start your paragraph by evaluating the topic sentence.

Review of Writing

Once you are done writing, review your work. Ensure that your topic sentence addresses the theme of the paragraph. Check whether you have all the relevant information and evidence. Check out for grammar, spelling, and punctuation mistakes. Make sure that you have used the correct sentence structure on paper. Review that you have added all-important and up-to-date information in the paper. Ensure the proper format and citation style of the section.
