The introductory section of the research paper should contain a strong statement that reflects the student's subject area. Students are not encouraged to start their paper by saying "In this paper..." or "I would like to...", instead, they should either start with a question that makes the reader ponder over

the problem or provide a factoid regarding the problem. However, the topic in question should have the element of clarity in it, since unambiguity and relevance have an upper hand on classical hooks.

Students should include at least one hypothesis backed up by strong evidence. This highlights their stance on the given problem and emits confidence to cater for the problem. It should be written in the past tense. A hypothesis is a tested statement used by students to improve the position of their paper. While writing an introduction, students should mention the knowledge gaps in the previous studies and then build up their argument from there to support their stance.

The introduction portion of the research paper is responsible for the solid flow of information from the beginning to the end of the paper therefore, it is necessary to summarize all the written material at the end of the introduction. There must be no grammatical error in the document, else it would give a bad impression of the student. Students must have clarity while describing the problem statement and should state what contributions this paper will make in the relevant field.
